

# **Project Benefits**

#### Reduce Congestion

- Improvements to Mudd Tavern Road and arterial roads
- Eliminate backup onto I-95 along ramps

#### Future Growth

- Increased capacity for projected traffic growth
- Accommodates increased vehicle trips during weekday peak hours

#### Enhance Safety

- Reduces potential for congestion-related crashes
- Adds bicycle and pedestrian accommodations along portions of Mudd Tavern Road

#### Replace I-95 Overpass


- Replaces the existing structurally deficient bridge
- Improves driver sight distance at ramps due to expanded lanes


Route 606 Bridge Replacement Over I-95 with Route 606 Improvements



DRYSTACK TEXTURE DETAIL


Parapet - Outside Face

# **Construction Sequence**





### **Construction Schedule**

Milestones	Date
Begin construction	October 2017
New overpass and approaches	Oct. 2017 - Nov. 2018
Mudd Tavern Road	Dec. 2017 - June 2019
Mallard Road	Dec. 2017 - June 2019
Northbound I-95 Ramps	Dec. 2017 - June 2019
Dominion Raceway Drive	Dec. 2017 - June 2019
Shift Mudd Tavern Road traffic onto new overpass	November 2018
Demolish existing bridge	Dec. 2018 - March 2019
Project completion	June 2019 - September 2019



# What can drivers expect during construction?

- Most construction will occur during daytime hours, generally 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Mudd Tavern Road will have an eastbound and westbound lane open during peak travel times
- During midday and overnight hours, Mudd
   Tavern Road and Mallard Road may be reduced
   to a single lane, with a flagging crew directing
   alternating, one-way traffic
- Weekend work will be used as makeup days due to weather
- Nighttime operations will result in noise impacts
- 30-minute temporary stoppages will be needed for overpass work and will be used only when backups are a half-mile or less
