Purpose and Need


- Reduce congestion
- Improve accessibility and mobility to and within the surrounding activity and employment centers
- Improve safety in heavy weaving and merging areas
- Address current and planned growth that will increase traffic volumes by 44-52% by 2040






Proposed Concept


- Convert 3 existing lanes to collector-distributor lanes for local traffic on I-95 southbound
- In the median, construct 3 through traffic lanes on I-95 southbound
- Construct new bridge over the Rappahannock River to carry the through lanes in median
- New lanes built from just north of Exit 133/Route 17 in Stafford County to just south of Exit 130/Route 3 interchange in Fredericksburg




I-95 at Route 17 (Exit 133)
